1. <u>Active members</u> - as of Jan. 22, 2019: Using the same categories I used last Fall for our Section Newsletter, CSSRM has 130 members. We had a total of 197 in these categories in September.

Geographic distribution:

- One new Regular member, an alum from CSU, lives in Mongolia.
- Twenty of the Regular members have addresses in ten (10) states other than Colorado.

2. <u>Not renewed:</u> When I sent eBlasts in January related to the 2019 Annual meeting, eighty-seven (87) went to those who showed as not yet 2019 members. At first glance Clare and I thought we might be seeing a dramatic negative effect of the federal government shutdown. But of those, we only had 15 federal employees (4=BLM, 5=USFS, 3=NRCS, 3=USGS) and the NRCS folks were still receiving emails.

A February 1 print-out sent from the SRM Business Office/Allen Press to Gary Frasier shows seventy-nine (79) still not 2019 members. These are people who did have memberships in 2018.

This Feb 1 print-out also shows "lapsed" memberships from 2017 and 2016. I've been looking at those names and calling a few people.

I do not think the 2016 names are worth pursuing, but I am trying to figure out 2017.

Already I can see some members who dropped from our Colorado Section in 2018 but who show up Active for 2019 n other states. I also talked two days ago with an Emeritus member who decided he "doesn't publish", is retired for nearly ten years and made a deliberate decision not to renew him membership for 2019.
